Whirlwind Warrior
11 1/2" x 23 1/2"
five-color stone lithograph
Arches buff paper

A characteristic occurrence on the dry plains was the springtime swarming of dragonflies, raising quantities of dust in a pattern resembling a whirlwind. This natural phenomenon convinced the Cheyenne that the dragonfly had protective powers.

The defensive posture and the yellow and red paint on the face of this Cheyenne fighting man signify his preparation for battle. His shield is adorned with dragonflies so that they will raise dust and, therefore, protect him from his enemies with a whirlwind. He carries a feathered society lance and wears a trade blanket and a fringed shirt typical of Southern Plains warriors in the last half of the nineteenth century.

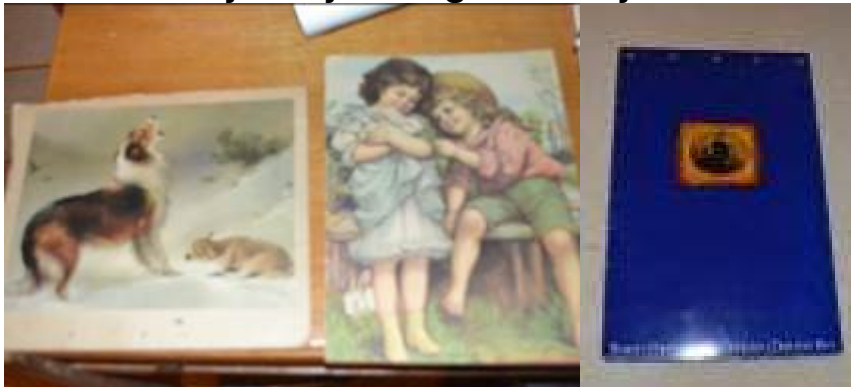

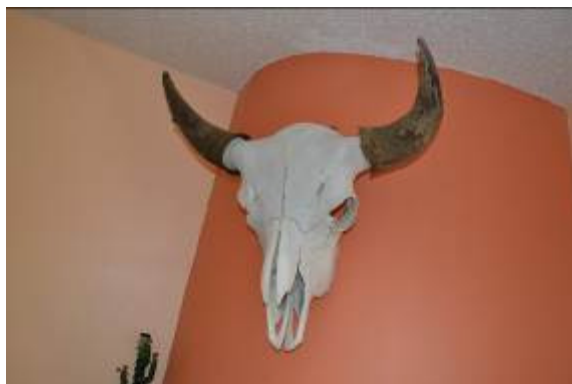

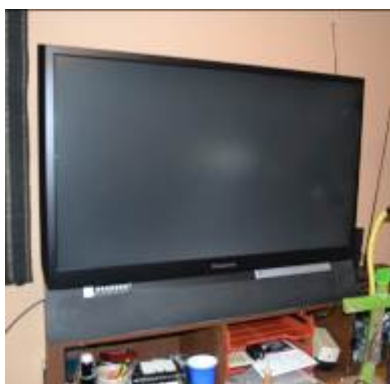
